We already use a lot of visual timetables in nursery for all ages and if you are struggling with behaviour at home and are finding it difficult, please ask staff for support. We all need to be on the same page when it comes to dealing with unwanted behaviours, so always share with staff what you are doing at home to support your child and we can work together as we have found that consistency pays off.



In the next few weeks your child will be coming home with a sticker with a QR code on it to download a new app to support parents with their child's development and learning. Easypeasy is an evidence led app with hundreds of simple ideas to support families with their children's learning it covers lots of things from communication to bedtime routines. We have posters on the door and in nursery with the QR code should you lose your sticker.

Staff are only available then at 3.15 to 6.00pm to answer the door we do not man the office daily, we are in the rooms and attending training and meetings.
